### HELP FUND OUR COMMUNITY FARM PILOT SCHEME BY SHARING IN OUR FIRST HARVEST!

We are excited to invite you to become a founding member of a brand new community supported agriculture enterprise that aims to connect people with the source of their food in the heart of our beautiful and bustling town of Wellington and adjoining Rockwell Green.

The purpose of the crop share is for members of the community to help support the farm by investing in the upcoming growing season. In exchange, they will receive a share of the harvest which we will aim to ensure is equivalent in value to the weekly value of the investment. Together, the shareholders share in the risk and reward since we cannot guarantee the size of the share each week while the project gets up to speed.

Our inital share will be limited to <u>20 members</u> on a first-come-first-serve basis. Members should be able to fund 6 months up front to support a weekly veg box scheme. We anticipate the harvest to yield May - October.

Once we are able to establish a cash flow, we would aim to shift to a monthly subscription model. In future, we also aim to offer Volunteer and Supporter Memberships options.

By investing in this community supported agricultural enterprise, individuals will be supporting the long-term stability and strength of the local economy, as well as the growth of a sustainable and environmentallyfriendly food and farming system. This investment will assist the farm in promoting inclusivity and accessibility for all, and serve as an example for other communities to emulate.
